## PUBLIC PRE-K

Do I have what I need to apply? Use the checklist below:

Child's birth certificate (Child's Birthdate between 10/1/19-9/30/20)

\_\_\_\_Child's social security card

- \_\_\_\_\_Child's current immunization (shot) record
  - Proof of domicile (street) address (homeowner-2 CURRENT bills (water/elect.) renter- Lease & 1 CURRENT bill; live with someone- Affidavit & 2 CURRENT bills for Affiant-water & elect.)

\_Proof of income (for every adult in home-two recent pay stubs) or SNAP case details (includes child's name, parent/guardian's name, AND expiration date-MUST BE CURRENT)

Guardianship, or Prov. Custody (filed with Clerk of Court) if applicable

Ready Start Terrebonne will offer registration with all Partners.

All participating Partners accept applications year-round.

## Do I have what I need to apply?

- ⇒ Head Start applications need everything listed for Public Pre-K as well as Child's Insurance Card
- ⇒ Early Learning Center applications only need Child's current immunization (shot) record



Please Note: All public school Pre-K applications are viewed for acceptance primarily according to income. Families above income guidelines are encouraged to apply and will be placed after income eligible families.
